

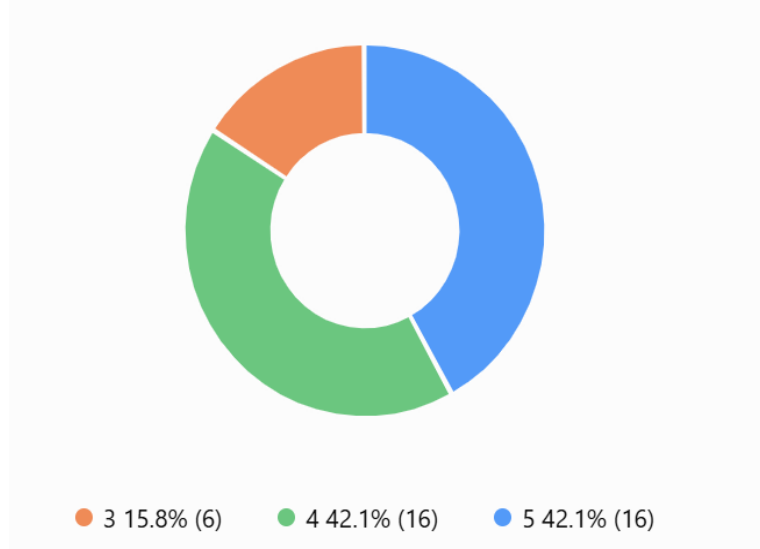

1. Your Rating Out of 5 For The Course Conducted In The College



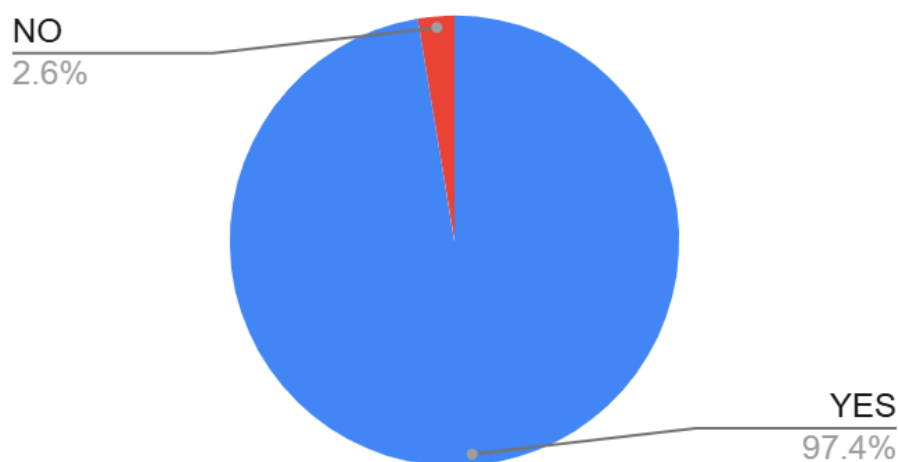
Analysis

The data indicates that **42.1% of students awarded the highest rating of 5**, while another **42.1% provided a rating of 4**, showing that a significant majority of students (**84.2%**) are highly satisfied with the courses offered by the college. Only **15.8% of respondents rated the courses with a score of 3**, indicating moderate satisfaction.

Findings:

2. WAS THERE TIMELY ORIENTATION FOR THE CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES?

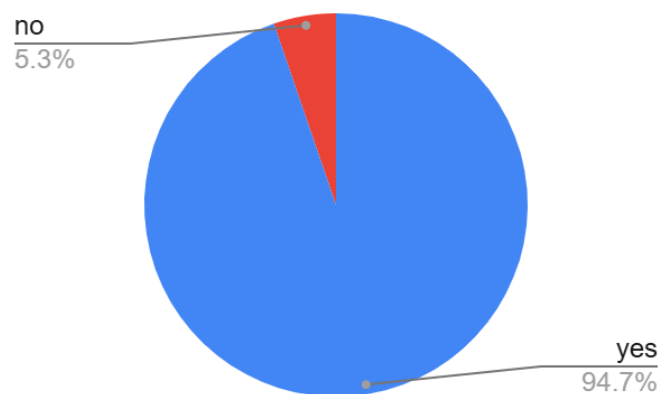


Analysis

- **Yes (1): 37 responses – 97.4%**
- **No (0): 1 response – 2.6%**

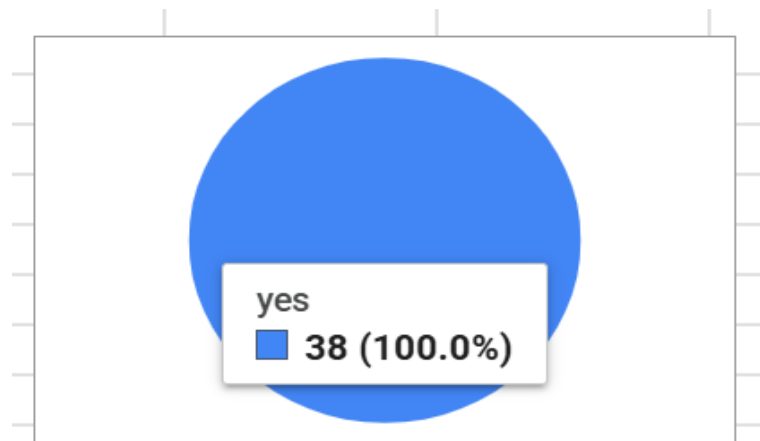
3.WAS INTERNAL EXAMS WERE HELD AND DONE BY FAIR MEANS?**Analysis:**

- **No (0): 2 responses – 5.3%**

4. Was Sufficient Number of Activities Conducted in The College?

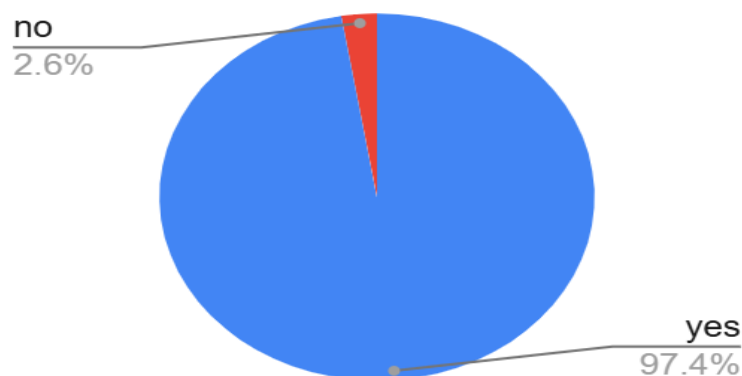


Findings:

5. Was Sufficient Hand Holding Done During This Courses?



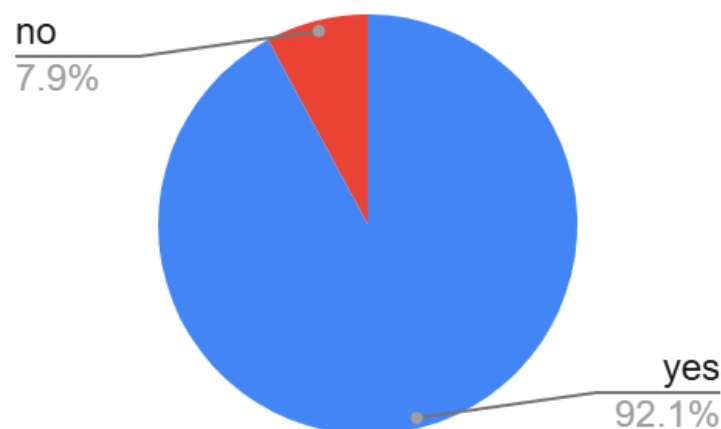
Analysis:

The survey results indicate that **35 respondents (92.1%) answered “Yes”**, while **3 respondents (7.9%) answered “No”**.

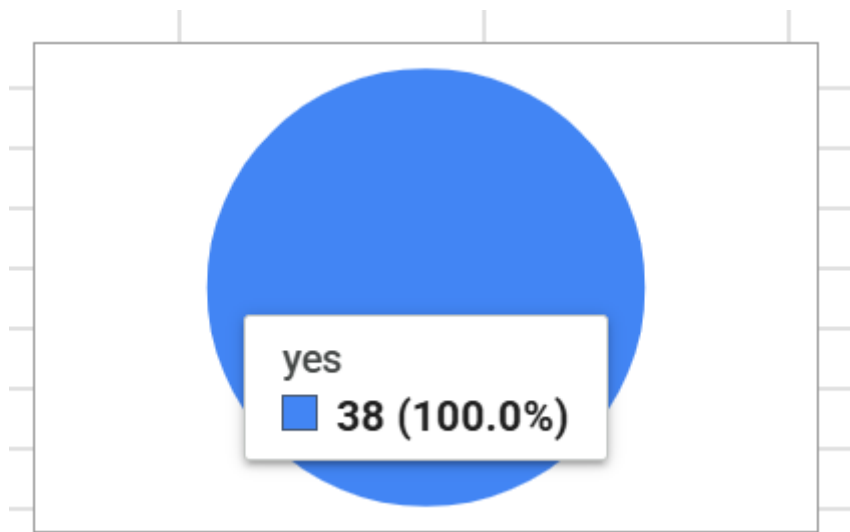
Findings:

7. Was Timetable Shared With You Regularly



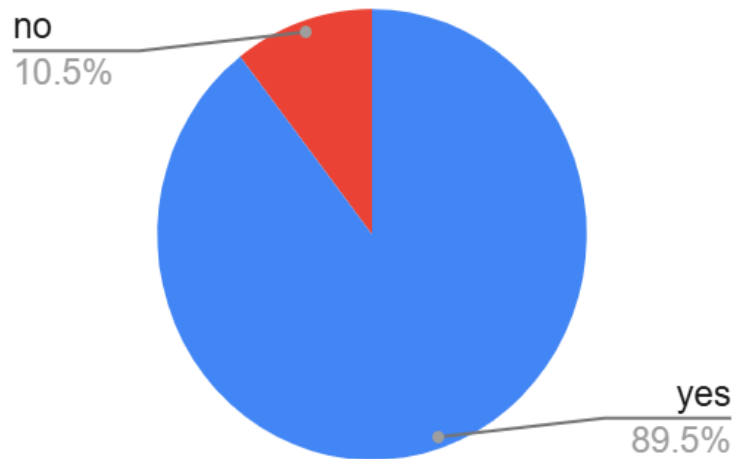
Analysis:

8. Was Community Service Done As Per The Norm?



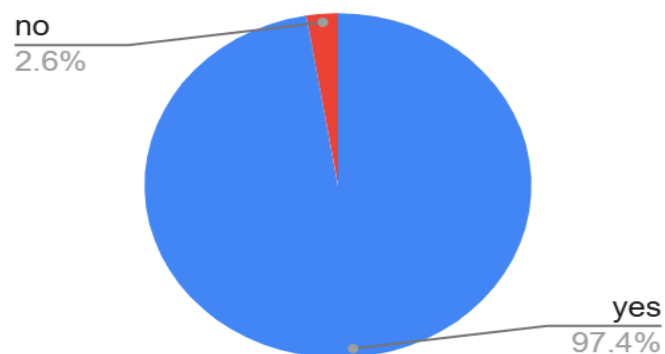
Analysis

9. Was Books Available In The Library?



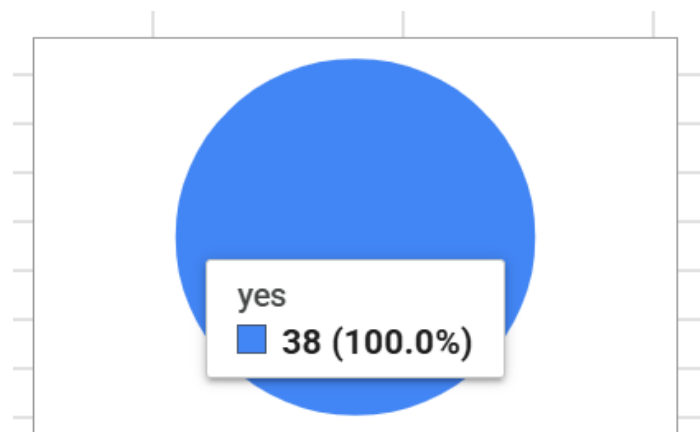
Analysis:
