

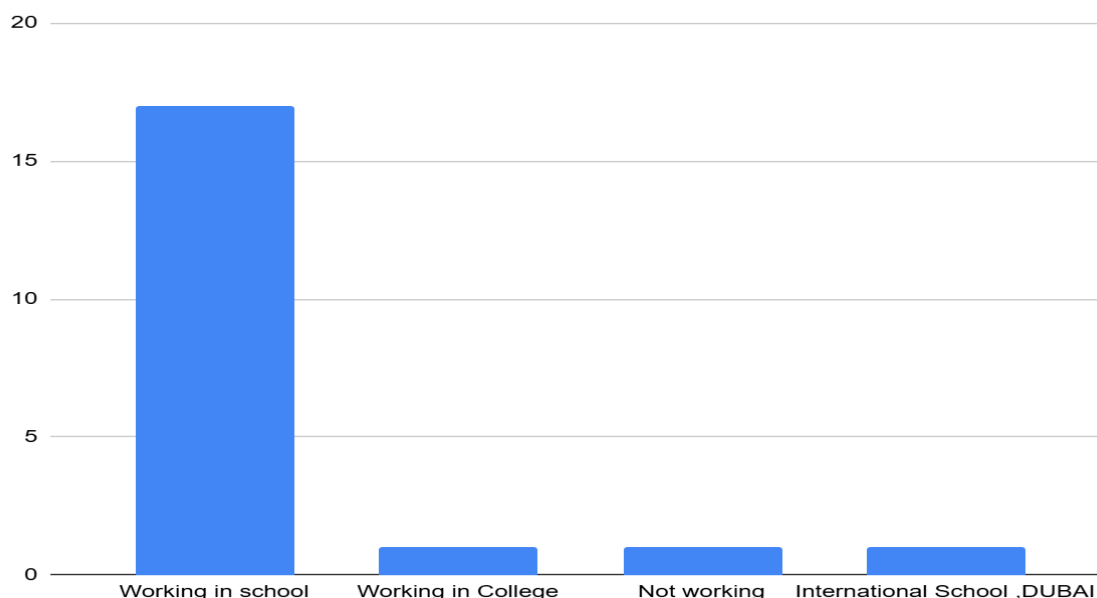

Placement Analysis of The Batch 2023-2025

Introduction:

The placement activities for the **B.Ed. Batch 2023–2025** were aimed at providing students with suitable career opportunities in the field of education and supporting their successful transition into the teaching profession. The data indicates that the majority of students have successfully entered the teaching profession, reflecting positive career outcomes after completion of the B.Ed. program.
